GOLFING:

HIKING

Get some altitude in Summerland with awe-inspiring views of Okanagan Lake and the town. Hike the trails up to the summit at <u>Giant's Head Mountain Park</u>, an extinct volcano which is now a mountain with a face that resembles the profile of a man. Hike the Summerland portion of the Trans Canada Trail overlooking farmlands and orchards to breathtaking views of canyons and a historic train trestle.

RAIL TOURS:

The <u>Kettle Valley Steam Railway</u> offers a unique two-hour steam powered train journey on one of BC's few remaining fully operational steam railways. From May to October, enjoy a tour along a preserved ten-kilometre section of the original railway. Fun for groups is the Great Train Robbery and BBQ. Experience the thrill of seeing the Garnett Valley Gang ride out of the hills, board the train, rob the passengers (for charity) then onto a BBQ at the KVSR Station.

TROUT HATCHERY:

The <u>Summerland Trout Hatchery</u>, located beside the Resort, is the oldest continuously running trout hatchery in B.C. offers year-round self-guided tours. Learn more about freshwater fisheries and conservation activities.
